This modern office development is situated in the Mokotow District of Warsaw was completed in 2001. The total area is 37,000 sq m with a total of 5 floors comprising offices, a cafe and internal and external garden areas. The high specification development is modern, warm and friendly with extensive use of natural oak and cedar materials. The southern elevation is glazed and the cedar framed floor to ceiling windows ensure plenty of natural light.

63 x CAM-35 and 960 Fantile units serve 5 floors of office space

Flexible Space was specified for the project for its energy efficiency and contribution towards the Green Building design

Adopting the Under Floor Air Conditioning concept allowed the elimination of the ceiling void and the introduction of cotton sails to enhance the thermal mass from the concrete downstand beams
